Applicants should be dedicated to a strong skills- and knowledge-based curriculum as well as high student achievement.

- BA/BS in Music or related discipline, or equivalent combination of relevant education and experience. Content knowledge is essential.

- Experience and proficiency with Core Knowledge Music History, Choir, and Theater instruction/direction.
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively in multiple teams.
- MS/MA in Music, or equivalent combination of relevant education and experience.
- Other relevant musical- or theater-related experience, including expertise in keyboard/accompaniment and dramatic theatrical productions.
